

**This year we will continue to roll out Mt. Fuji Round Trip Ticket,
 A Convenient Ticket for Tourists Visiting Japan**
 Narita Express (N'EX) will be extended to Kawaguchiko

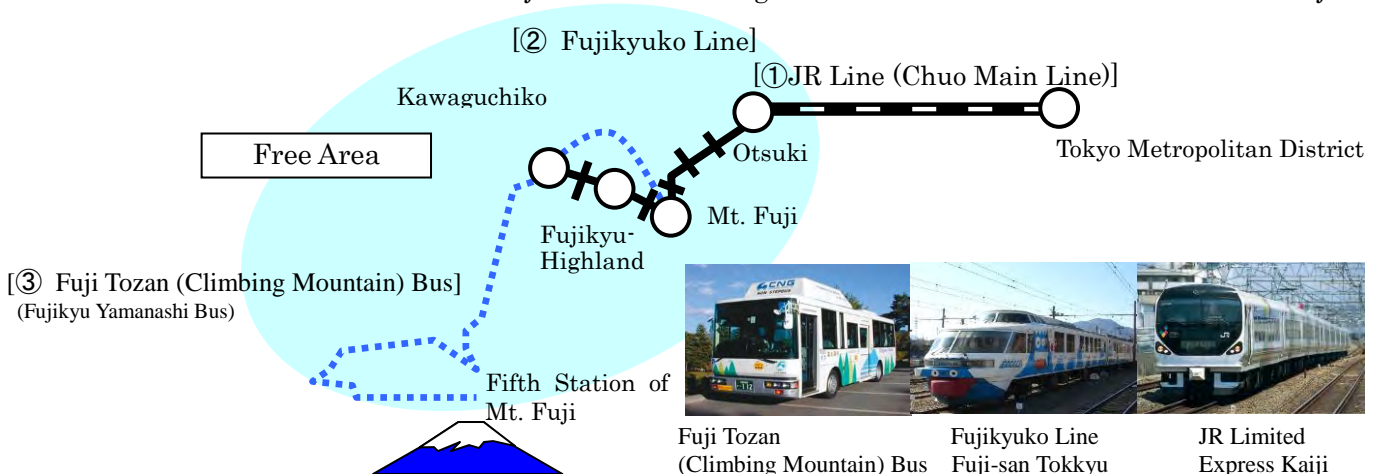
This year as well, JR East will commence the limited-time sale of the Mt. Fuji Round Trip Ticket, a discounted ticket for tourists visiting Japan to sightsee near Mt. Fuji. The pass provides unlimited use for two days in the Free Area on the Fujikyuko Line and Fuji Tozan (Climbing Mountain) Bus. It can also be used for round trips from the Tokyo Metropolitan District to the Free Area on Limited Express trains on the Chuo Main Line. For example, this convenient discount ticket can be used at approximately half of the regular price for round-trip travel from Shinjuku Station to the Fifth Station of Mt. Fuji.

This summer, Narita Express (N'EX) will be directly connected to the Fujikyuko line for the first time, facilitating travel towards the Mt. Fuji area. Passengers may now travel from Narita Airport to Kawaguchiko without the need to transfer.

We invite you to use this convenient ticket to enjoy travel around Mt. Fuji in comfortable trains on the Chuo Line and Fujikyuko Line.

- ◇ Eligibility Only for overseas customers who have a non-Japanese passport.
 * We will check your passport at the time of purchase.
- ◇ Ticket Details
 - 1) Reserved seats in Ordinary cars on the Limited Express, Rapid, and Local trains between the Tokyo Metropolitan District and Otsuki Station (round trip)
 - 2) Unlimited use on the Fuji-san Tokkyu (unreserved seats), Rapid, and Local trains between Otsuki Station and Kawaguchiko Station on the Fujikyuko Line
 *A seat-type ticket is required for the No. 1 car of the Fuji-san Tokkyu (Limited Express trains); a seat ticket is required for the Fuji Tozan Train. Additional charges apply.
 - 3) Unlimited use on the Fuji Tozan (Climbing Mountain) Bus (Fujikyu Yamanashi Bus) between Fujisan Station/Kawaguchiko Station and the Fifth Station of Mt. Fuji



2. Narita Express (N'EX) to be extended to Kawaguchiko Station

The Narita Express (N'EX) departing from and arriving at Narita Airport will be extended to Kawaguchiko Station on the Fujikyuko Line

◆Period: Saturdays, Sundays, and holiday from July 26 (Saturday) to September 28 (Sunday)

◆Trains that will be extended to Kawaguchiko Station

* Passengers holding the “Mt. Fuji Round Trip Ticket” can ride between Tokyo and Kawaguchiko (round-trip).

* Passengers holding both the “N'EX TOKYO Direct Ticket (One-way)” and the “Mt. Fuji Round Trip Ticket” can ride from Narita Airport to Kawaguchiko (outbound one-way) and from Kawaguchiko to Shinjuku/Tokyo (homebound one-way).

* Passengers holding the “JR Kanto Area Pass” can ride between Narita Airport and Kawaguchiko (round-trip).
