JR Kanto Area Pass to Go on Sale

On Thursday, December 1, 2011, JR East will commence sale of the JR Kanto Area Pass, a wonderfully user-friendly rail pass that makes it easier for tourists visiting Japan to take full advantage of JR East's outstanding rail service. The pass enables holders to unlimited use on Shinkansen (bullet trains) and Limited Express trains in the Kanto area for three days. It is perfect for access to metropolitan airports by Narita Express and Tokyo Monorail, and excursions from Tokyo to Lake Kawaguchi, Izu, Kusatsu, Karuizawa, Nasu Highlands, Nikko and other popular destinations.

◇ Period for Use: From Sun, January 1, 2012 Year round

◇ Date of Sales: From Thu, December 1, 2011 Year round

◇ Valid For: 3 consecutive days

◇ Sold At

- JR East Travel Service Centers (Located at Narita Airport Station, Narita Airport Terminal 2 Station, and Tokyo Monorail Haneda Airport International Terminal Station); Tokyo, Narita Airport, and Narita Airport Terminal 2 Stations; View Plaza Counters at Shinagawa, Shinjuku, Shibuya, Ikebukuro, Ueno, and Yokoyama Stations.

◇ Price: Adults 8,000 yen, Children 4,000 yen

◇ Features:

The pass allows unlimited use of reserved Ordinary cars on all Limited Express trains (including Shinkansen "bullet trains"), Express and Local trains on the JR East lines in the Free Area, the entire Tokyo Monorail Line, the entire Izu Kyuko Line, the entire Fuji Kyuko Line, the entire Joshin Dentetsu Line and Saitama New Urban Transit (Omiya to The Railway Museum).

* Separate limited express charges are required to board the Tohoku Shinkansen *Hayabusa*.


* This pass is not valid for the Tokaido Shinkansen.

* A numbered seat ticket is required for the observation car of the Fujisan Express, and a seat ticket is required for the Fuji Tozan Densha on the Fuji Kyuko Line (separate charges apply).

◇ Other

- Available only to foreign nationality passport holders (regardless of the duration of stay in Japan). Passport will be checked at time of purchase.
- The first 1,000 customers to purchase the JR Kanto Area Pass at the JR East Travel Service Center (located at Narita Airport Station, Narita Airport Terminal 2 Station, and Tokyo Monorail Line Haneda Airport International Terminal Station) will receive our original Neck Strap.
