- JR EAST PASS holders must reserve train seats in advance, and a 'JR EAST PASS Tobu Line Ticket' which can save on fares is available at the point of making reservations.
- If a 'JR EAST PASS Tobu Line Ticket' is not purchased, a full fare charge for the Tobu Line must be paid aboard the train.
- Since Japan Rail Pass holders cannot purchase a 'JR EAST PASS Tobu Line Ticket', please pay the fare charge for the Tobu Line in between Kurihashi Station and Tōbu-nikkō Station or Kinugawa-onsen Station aboard trains.

The JR EAST PASS may be used on any JR EAST railway lines, including Shinkansen and other limited express (except private compartments or berths), express (some exceptions, i.e. sleeper cars), and local trains (except the Liner and the Home Liner).

The JR EAST PASS is available in two types, for Green Cars and ordinary cars. Each pass type is available as a 5-day, a 10-day, or a Flexible 4-day PASS. Children's tickets and youth tickets are also available.

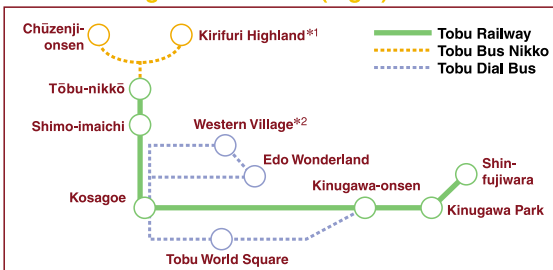
◆Ticket available at:

JR Ticket Office (Midori-no-madoguchi) and Travel Service Center (View Plaza) of major JR stations in the metropolitan area, as well as at TOBU TRAVEL and other major travel agencies (some exceptions apply).

◆Details

- Reserved seats in the ordinary car on the Limited Express Nikkō (Spacia Nikkō) and the Limited Express Kinugawa (Spacia Kinugawa) can be used to get to and from the Free Area.
- The Free Area is shown in fig.1. The ticket allows unlimited travel on Tobu Railway local trains and rapid trains, as well as the buses as shown on the figure.

◆Nikkō/Kinugawa Free Area (Fig.1)



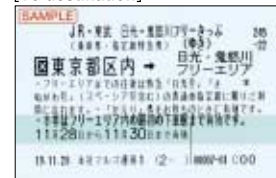

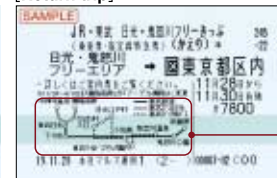

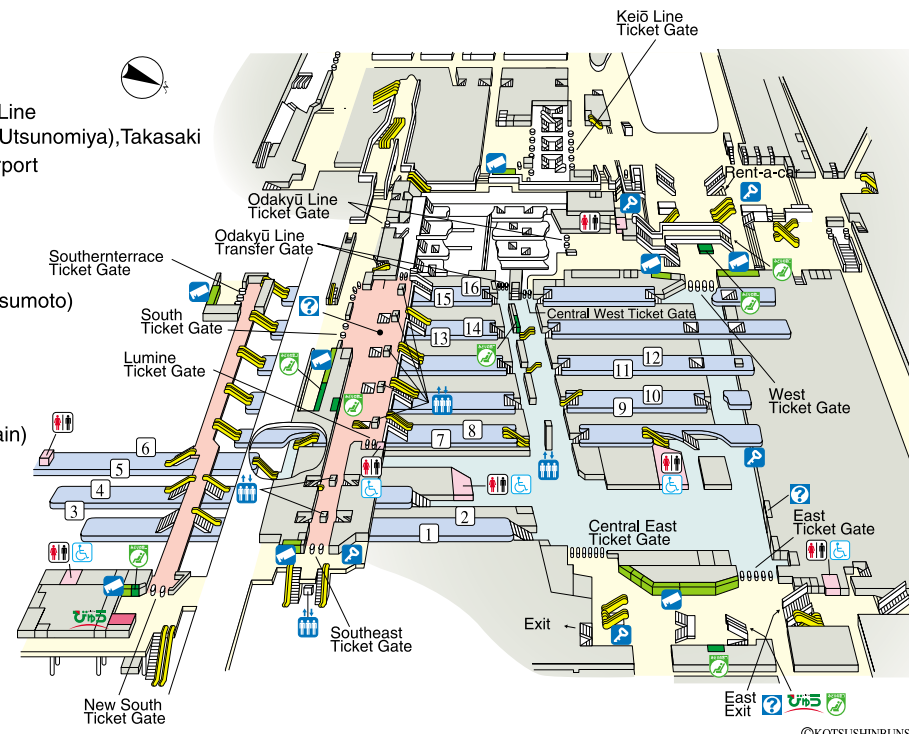
JR Line Major Station Interior Map

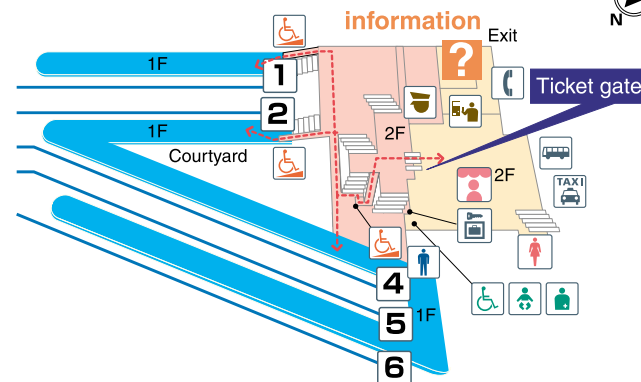

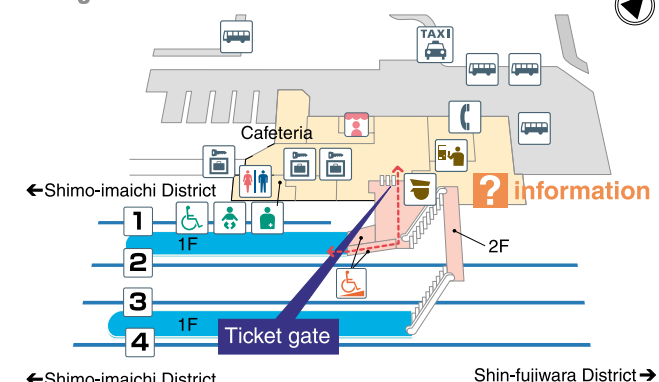
Tobu Line Major Station Interior Map

Relax in a hot spring and experience 1,200 years of history and the magnificence of nature.

Nikko is home to 103 ancient structures including the Toshogu Shrine (erected for Tokugawa Ieyasu, the founder of the Tokugawa Shogunate), Futarasan Shrine, and Rinnoji Temple. These historical structures and their surroundings are registered as a World Heritage site and still exude an aura of ancient times. The ever-changing panoramas of waterfalls, marshes, mountains and other scenery provide an excellent chance to experience the beauty of nature first hand.

Kinugawa is one of Japan's foremost hot-spring resort towns and is located close to Nikko. Kinugawa's hot springs became popular during the 17th century for their therapeutic qualities, and today it is a leisure spot renowned for its theme parks and other facilities.



Guide to Nikko and Kinugawa

Sightseeing in the Nikko and Kinugawa area gives you both views of natural beauty and access to many historic structures including shrines and temples designated as World Heritage sites. Embark on a relaxing vacation filled with new discoveries.



3 Kegon Falls
One of Japan's three most famous waterfalls with a height of approximately 100m. The colors of each season make it a beautiful location year-round.

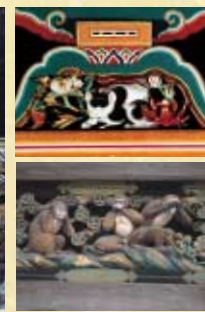


5 Shinkyo (Sacred Bridge)
A cinnabar varnished wooden bridge that serves as the gateway to Nikko mountains. Honored as a sacred bridge since olden times, the Shinkyo is one of Japan's three finest bridges.

4 Futarasan Shrine
World Heritage
This shrine has offered sanctuary to the faithful as a protector of the Kanto region ever since its construction in the year 790. It contains many structures and artifacts that have been designated as important cultural treasures, including the main hall and the sacred gate.



2 Rinnoji Temple
World Heritage
The temple in which the three great Buddhas of the Nikko mountains are enshrined. In addition to the thirty-eight historical structures that make up the temple, there is also much to see in the gardens, treasury, and other areas.



1 Toshogu Shrine
World Heritage
This mausoleum was constructed in 1617 for Tokugawa Ieyasu, the first shogun of the Edo Shogunate. The finest Edo-era craftsmanship is featured on the wall carvings in the shrine pavilions, including the Three Monkeys and the Sleeping Cat, the latter of which is a national treasure. The Toshogu Shrine was registered as a World Heritage site in 1999, along with the Rinnoji Temple and the Futarasan Shrine.



9 Edo Wonderland, Nikko Edo Mura
A theme park that includes a re-creation of an Edo-era town with inns and samurai residences.



7 Kinugawa Onsen
Located near the Kinugawa River, the nature surrounding these famous Kanto Region hot springs is beautiful year-round. The baths have been known to relieve neuralgia and fatigue.



8 Tobu World Square
It took five years to construct this theme park where 102 of the world's most famous buildings have been recreated in delightful detail at a scale of 1:25.



6 Kinugawa River Ride
Enjoy a six-kilometer ride in a traditional boat, floating down the crystal-clear Kinugawa River. View the beautiful scenery along its banks and marvel at rock formations that resemble animals and other shapes.
