
In the future, we will work even harder to promote tourist routes together with local communities so that even more overseas visitors can enjoy their holiday in the Eastern Japan area.

 - * It will not be on sale anywhere other than at the above locations.
- Prices Adults (aged 12 and over) ¥9,000, children (aged 6 to 11) ¥4,500
- Requirements Customers who are foreign nationals with a non-Japanese passport, and whose nature of stay is a "Short Stay" of no more than 90 days
- Validity One way "Nagano Dentetsu Toyama" or "Dentetsu Toyama Nagano"
 - Cannot be used for round trips or return trips in the middle of the route
