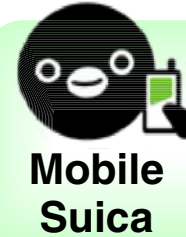


Appendix 3: From the beginning to the end of trips



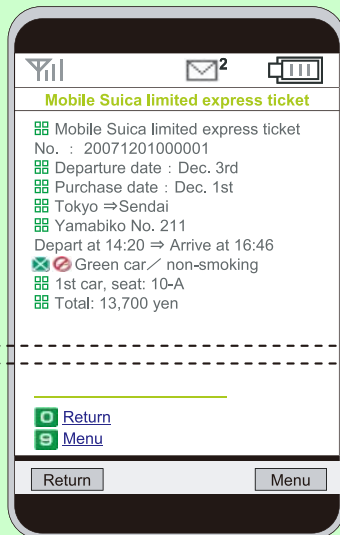
No need to receive tickets at station counters or from ticket vending machines!



Mobile Suica lets registered customers pass through ticket gates within the Suica service area with just a brief touch of their phone to the Shinkansen ticket gate sensor (“Touch and Go”).

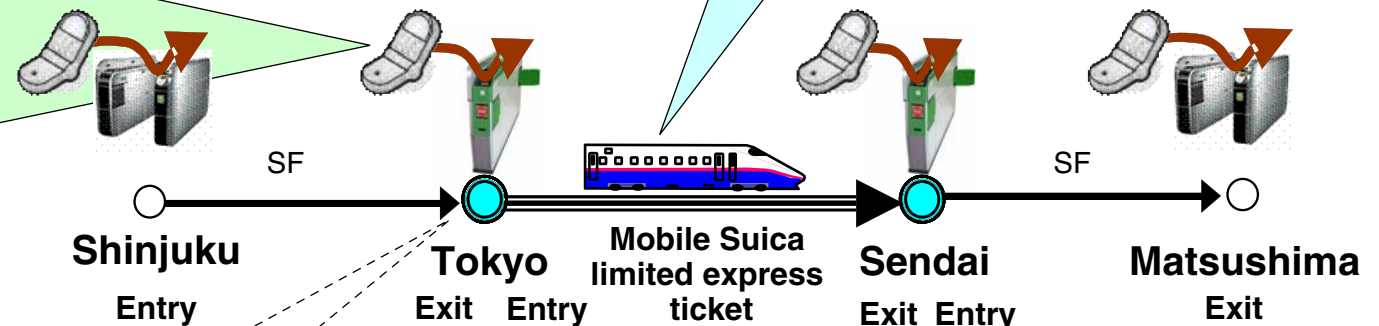
* For conventional lines, customers can use the stored fare (SF: e-money) charged to their Mobile Suica, regular tickets, or their commuter passes.

Information of purchased tickets can be checked by cellular phone.

At Tokyo Station's Shinkansen transfer gates, when customers briefly touch the gate sensor with their Mobile Suica, the fares for the conventional lines between Shinjuku and Tokyo will automatically be deducted from their SF (e-money) and check-in entry will be processed as a Mobile Suica limited express ticket.

* Different from ordinary Shinkansen tickets, conventional line fares for Tokyo, the Yamanote Line, and Sendai city are not included in the services.

→Conventional line fares to and from Shinkansen stations are needed.
