


Hokuriku Arch Pass

Unlimited-ride Pass for affordable trips in Tokyo/Osaka and Hokuriku areas!

How to Purchase

① On the website

Make a purchase on JR-EAST Train Reservation or JR-WEST ONLINE TRAIN RESERVATION, then claim your pass at designated exchange locations in Japan.

② At an overseas travel agency

Purchase a ticket exchange order from an overseas travel agency and exchange it for a pass at an exchange location in Japan.

Validity period 7 consecutive days

Eligibility

The pass is available for foreign nationals with a non-Japanese passport **who enter Japan under the entry status of Temporary Visitor valid for 90 days or less**. The passport is required for confirmation purposes at the time of purchase/exchange.

Valid Train Routes and Train Types


This pass allows unlimited rides using reserved seats or non-reserved seats on the ordinary cars of the limited express trains (including Shinkansen), express trains, and local trains in the area of Kansai Airport - Keihanshin and Nara area - Hokuriku area - Tokyo ward area - Narita/Haneda Airport. Reservations are required for reserved seats.

* Be advised that some trains are reserved seats only. This includes Hokuriku Shinkansen "Kagayaki" and Limited Express "Kounotori", "Kinosaki", "Hashidate", "Maizuru", "Kuroshio", "Narita Express", etc.

- Limited Express "Haruka" between Kansai-Airport and Shin-Osaka/Kyoto
- Limited Express "Thunderbird" between Osaka and Tsuruga, Hokuriku Shinkansen between Tsuruga and Tokyo
- Limited Express "Narita Express" within Available Area
- Tokyo Monorail between Hamamatsucho and Haneda Airport
- JR lines in Keihanshin Area (Osaka, Kyoto, Kobe and Nara), JR lines within Tokyo ward area
- Etsumi-Hoku Line, Nanao Line, Himi Line, Johana Line, Takayama Main Line (Toyama - Inotani), Oito line (Itoigawa - Minami-Otari)
- IR Ishikawa Railway, Ainokaze Toyama Railway, Noto Railway, HAPI-LINE FUKUI * There are some conditions for riding.
- * Gran Class and Green Cars are not available.
- * Tokaido Shinkansen (Shin-Osaka - Kyoto - Tokyo) is not available.

1. Use on the IR Ishikawa Railway is limited to transit between Kanazawa and Tsubata Stations only. Pass-holder does not alight from the IR Ishikawa Railway.
2. Use on the Ainokaze Toyama Railway is limited to transit between Takaoka and Toyama Stations only. Pass-holder does not alight from the Ainokaze Toyama Railway.
3. Use on the HAPI-LINE FUKUI is limited to transit between Fukui and Echizen-Hanando Stations only. Pass-holder does not alight from the HAPI-LINE FUKUI.

On the website

Passes purchased via JR-EAST Train Reservation can conveniently be picked up at Reserved Seat Ticket Vending Machines with a passport reader!

Information

- This pass does not guarantee you a seat on any particular train. To reserve a seat (at no additional charge), you must apply in advance via the JR-EAST Train Reservation website, a Reserved Seat Ticket Vending Machine, a JR-EAST or JR-WEST Ticket Office (Midori-no-madoguchi), a JR-EAST Travel Service Center, or a JR-WEST Travel Service Center. To travel in a Non-Reserved seat, all you need is this pass. Please note that some trains are reserved seats only.
- If you travel in the Green Car on a Local Train, you must pay an extra charge besides the pass. If you travel in the Green Car or GranClass in a Shinkansen, Limited Express or Rapid Service, you must pay the associated express charge as well as the extra charge. If you travel in a Sleeping Car, you must pay the associated express charge as well as the extra charge and basic fare. You cannot change your ticket to a Reserved seat or Sleeping Car after boarding.
- The pass cannot be reissued if lost or stolen.
- JR is unable to extend the validity of the pass or issue refunds for any reason, including due to service cancellation or delays after use of the pass has begun. Similarly, JR is not liable for costs incurred by passholders as a result of changes in scheduled service, including transportation or lodging expenses.
