This is a notice regarding the date of the revised prices of the JAPAN RAIL PASS and the expansion of products as announced by the JR Group on April 14, 2023.

1 Date of the revised prices of the JAPAN RAIL PASS

New prices will apply to tickets purchased from October 1, 2023 (Sunday).

* When purchasing a ticket on the dedicated website, JAPAN RAIL PASS Reservation, the revised prices will be applied from 4:00 a.m. (Japan standard time) on October 1.

* If purchasing an Exchange Order at an overseas JR-designated sales office or agency, the local time at the place of purchase will be used.

2 Expansion of products

(1) Sale of a special "[ONLY WITH JAPAN RAIL PASS] NOZOMI MIZUHO Ticket"

We will start selling a special "[ONLY WITH JAPAN RAIL PASS] NOZOMI MIZUHO Ticket" (hereinafter "NOZOMI MIZUHO Ticket") for JAPAN RAIL PASS holders. This ticket can be used for "NOZOMI" trains that run on the Tokaido and Sanyo Shinkansen Lines and "MIZUHO" trains that run on the Sanyo and Kyushu Shinkansen Lines (hereinafter "NOZOMI, etc.").

Please purchase one "NOZOMI MIZUHO Ticket" per use of NOZOMI, etc.

* There are a limited number of reserved seats in Green cars and Ordinary cars. Tickets may not be available even when there are open seats.

(2) Discounts on the use of tourist facilities in Japan

Starting from October 1, 2023, major tourist facilities in Japan are planning to offer discounts and other services to JAPAN RAIL PASS holders. The details will be announced on the JAPAN RAIL PASS website (<https://japanrailpass.net/>) around early September when available.

3 Other

- The JAPAN RAIL PASS has been sold at ticket offices in Japan on a pilot basis, but starting from October 1, 2023, all JAPAN RAIL PASS sales must be purchased through the dedicated website.
- Japanese nationals who reside overseas and meet the conditions for using the JAPAN RAIL PASS are asked to purchase an Exchange Order at a JR-designated sales office or agency prior to departure to Japan, as before. The sales period of the Exchange Orders was announced to end on December 31, 2023, but it will now be extended to December 31, 2025.
- The prices will also be revised for the other rail passes for travelers visiting Japan that are offered by each JR company (excluding JR Shikoku). Please see the website, etc. of each JR company.

5 Overview of the ticket

(1) Conditions for sale

- Tickets can be purchased when a JAPAN RAIL PASS (hereinafter referred to as “PASS”) holder uses a “NOZOMI” or “MIZUHO” train within the valid period of the PASS.
- For PASS (Green-type) holders, a ticket for Green cars, reserved seats in Ordinary cars, and non-reserved seats in standard cars will be available.
- For PASS (Ordinary-type) holders, tickets for reserved seats in Ordinary cars and non-reserved seats in Ordinary cars will be available (tickets for Green cars will not be available).
- Tickets for Green cars and reserved seats in Ordinary cars will be sold by train, and tickets for non-reserved seats in Ordinary cars will be sold on a one-way basis.
- There are a limited number of reserved seats in Green cars and Ordinary cars. Tickets may not be available even when there are open seats.
- Tickets for children are also available.

(2) Sales locations

JR ticket offices (Midori-no-madoguchi), reserved-seat ticket machines, Travel Service Centers, and JR-associated travel agencies nationwide

(3) Validity

- The Green cars, reserved seats in the Ordinary cars, non-reserved seats in Ordinary cars on the “NOZOMI” or “MIZUHO” train can be used only when the ticket is used in combination with the PASS that is valid as of the day of using the train, regardless of the date of exchange or purchase of the PASS.
- The ticket may not be used in combination with other tickets than the PASS.
- The ticket is valid only when it is used for the section indicated on the ticket and in the direction and route specified on the ticket.
- When the user gets off the train at a station that is not the destination, the ticket will become invalid for the remaining section.
- The valid period will be one day.
- Excluding non-reserved seats in Ordinary cars, the ticket will be valid only for the designated trains and facilities.

(4) Change of trains (before the designated train leaves)

- Tickets for Green cars and reserved seats in Ordinary cars may be changed once only to the same type of car/seat before the reserved train leaves the ticketed station.
- For tickets for non-reserved seats in Ordinary cars, the day of use may be changed once to a non-reserved seat in an Ordinary car on another day as long as it is within the valid period.
