Notice of Suspension of Service on Part of the Utsunomiya Line

Sunday, April 28, from about 21:00 to Monday, April 29 (holiday), about 8:00

Note: If construction cannot be carried out due to inclement weather or other reasons, it will be postponed to Saturday, June 8, from 21:00 to Sunday, June 9, about 8:00.

The plan for operation of the sections of the Utsunomiya Line related to the renovation of the Furutone River Bridge and track switching work for river improvement will be as follows.

(Ueno-Tōkyō Line route and Shōnan-Shinjuku Line route)

Utsunomiya Line Suspended between Kuki and Koga Stations

Return at Kuki Station, head toward Ueno at Shiraoka Station, head toward Shinjuku at Koga Station, head toward Utsunomiya

Note: Some early morning trains on the 29th will be suspended between Tōkyō and Ueno Stations.


Takasaki Line

First trains on Monday, April 29 (holiday)


Heading away from Tōkyō

Heading toward Tōkyō


The train leaving Utsunomiya about 7:20, and leaving Oyama about 7:40.

Substitute bus transportation

Hours of operation: Sunday, April 28, from about 21:00 to the last train; Monday, April 29 (holiday), from the first train to about 8:00.



Buses run at intervals of about 5 to 15 minutes

- The number of buses will vary depending on the time of day.
- The time required for the substitute bus may be longer due to road conditions or congestion.
- To use the substitute bus transportation service, you will need a Basic Fare Ticket or commuter pass (includes Suica commuter passes, etc.) for the JR section you will be traveling on.
- The charge portion of IC cards, such as Suica cards and Suica commuter passes, cannot be used for substitute bus transportation so please purchase a ticket in advance for the JR section you will be traveling on.
- There will be no connections between trains and substitute buses at Kuki Station and Koga Station, or between substitute buses at Kurihashi Station.
- There will be no direct bus service between Kuki and Koga Stations.
